## 9. Work Programme 2022

- Conference EIANZ's conference might be held in Auckland in November 2022. If this is the case, we will seek collaboration to have a session on a particular topic of NZAIA's interest like what we did a few years ago. Richard will follow up to confirm this with EIANZ.
- Impact Connector Three topics were identified, including Infrastructure and Impact Assessment (including how impact assessment contributes to climate change mitigation and adaptation), Environmental Valuation and Economic Instruments for Environmental Management (including payment for ecosystem services), and Public Policy and Impact Assessment (including how tools such as SEA and RIA can be used to inform public policy and achieve SDGs). Editor(s) will be identified to lead the development of each Issue. The editor(s) will first develop a brief editorial commentary of what an Issue should cover, which will then become an introductory paper. Alternatively, the editor(s) could set an editorial scope and invite people to contribute.
- Strategic Planning We'll revisit the existing working groups (Governance, Policy Framework, Internal and External Relations), take stock, and redefine the work programme in the 1<sup>st</sup> core group meeting next year.
- Workshop/webinar The Core Group will be invited via email to provide workshop / webinar ideas that can be organised to provide extra services to NZAIA members and the wider impact assessment community throughout the year
- Associate organisations A representative from SPREP will be invited to join the Core Group to strengthen our collaboration with them.
