  are other possibilities (3 Waters, RMA changes). The topic will be confirmed in
  the next CG meeting, and should be closely related to an Impact Connector
  issue (see below).

Richard and Kate will help coordinate the Conference Working Group, which comprises most of the meeting participants.

### 10. Impact Connector

The following 3 issues were planned:

- Infrastructure and Impact Assessment (including how impact assessment contributes to climate change mitigation and adaptation) – We'll aim to complete this first Issue by May. Nick has accepted to be an editor of this Issue.
- Environmental Valuation and Economic Instruments for Environmental Management (including payment for ecosystem services) – We'll aim to complete this second Issue by September. Sophal has accepted to be an editor of this Issue.
- Public Policy and Impact Assessment (including how tools such as SEA and RIA can be used to inform public policy and achieve SDGs) – This is a postconference issue, so some papers from the conference will be selected for
