What is the CEnvP Scheme?

The CEnvP Scheme is the leading certifying body for environmental and social practitioners across Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand with over 1100 certified practitioners today.

Launched in late 2022, the **CEnvP Social Impact Assessment** specialist certification is now accepting applications.

The certification raises the bar on SIA practice through specialist certification of social practitioners. Key proficiencies include: applying SIA; implementing social research approaches and methods; and engaging effectively with keys stakeholders and communities, to deliver improved project design and social/ community outcomes.



Established in 2004, by the EIANZ Inc, different certifications of the CEnvP Scheme are increasing in their recognition.

Certification is a requirement across many more local and regional government tendering and engagement processes.

All CEnvP Certified Practitioners must commit to the **EIANZ Code of Ethics & Professional Conduct**.

A key component is to **promote environmental principles** to 'advocate the protection of environmental values and the mitigation of environmental harm, using a multiple evidence base, that draws on science, Indigenous and community knowledge.'

Reasons Regulators, Proponents and Employers should require CEnvPs

- **Competency** - All CEnvPs are assessed to meet set standards of competence.
- **Quality** - Work is conducted by suitably qualified and experienced practitioners.
- **Ethical Practice** - To remain certified, every CEnvP is required to regularly recommit to uphold ethical and professional conduct.
- **Efficiency** - Reducing risk in reassessments needing to be undertaken.

CEnvP Scheme Governance

The CEnvP Scheme adheres to **ISO17024** for the certification of persons, as recommended by the Head of EPAs. The CEnvP Scheme has an **impartial and independent** governing Board; public **complaints management** processes on ethical practice, regular ISO17024 **audit** program; **open to all** regardless of affiliations.
