



Treasurer's Report to NZAIA AGM for the 2020 calendar year.

It is my pleasure to report to the members on the state of the finances for the New Zealand Association for Impact Assessment Incorporated.

2020 was an unusual year for many organisations. Unfortunately, due to the COVID-19 pandemic NZAIA were unable to hold our annual conference. The annual conference makes up a significant proportion of our organisational income and expenditure, and as such our total financial activity in 2020 was significantly reduced compared to previous years. Without a conference, we were unable to provide scholarships for students to attend.

The number of membership subscriptions decreased slightly, reflecting in part the reduced organisational visibility that our conferences generate. Membership subscriptions have been retained at the same fee since 2018, with standard memberships being \$50, and student and low-income memberships at \$20. All NZAIA members have paid their annual subscription fees. Invoicing of subscription fees was undertaken at the end of April to remain consistent with previous year's invoicing. This annual routine of invoicing subscriptions has helped to improve the reliability of NZAIA subscription funds.

As with previous years, we have continued to reinvest approximately \$5,000 in BNZ term deposits to keep our reserve funds in good order.

NZAIA is a registered charity, and submitted its 2020 annual return to Charities Services in June 2021. All reports can be found on the Charities Services link:
