

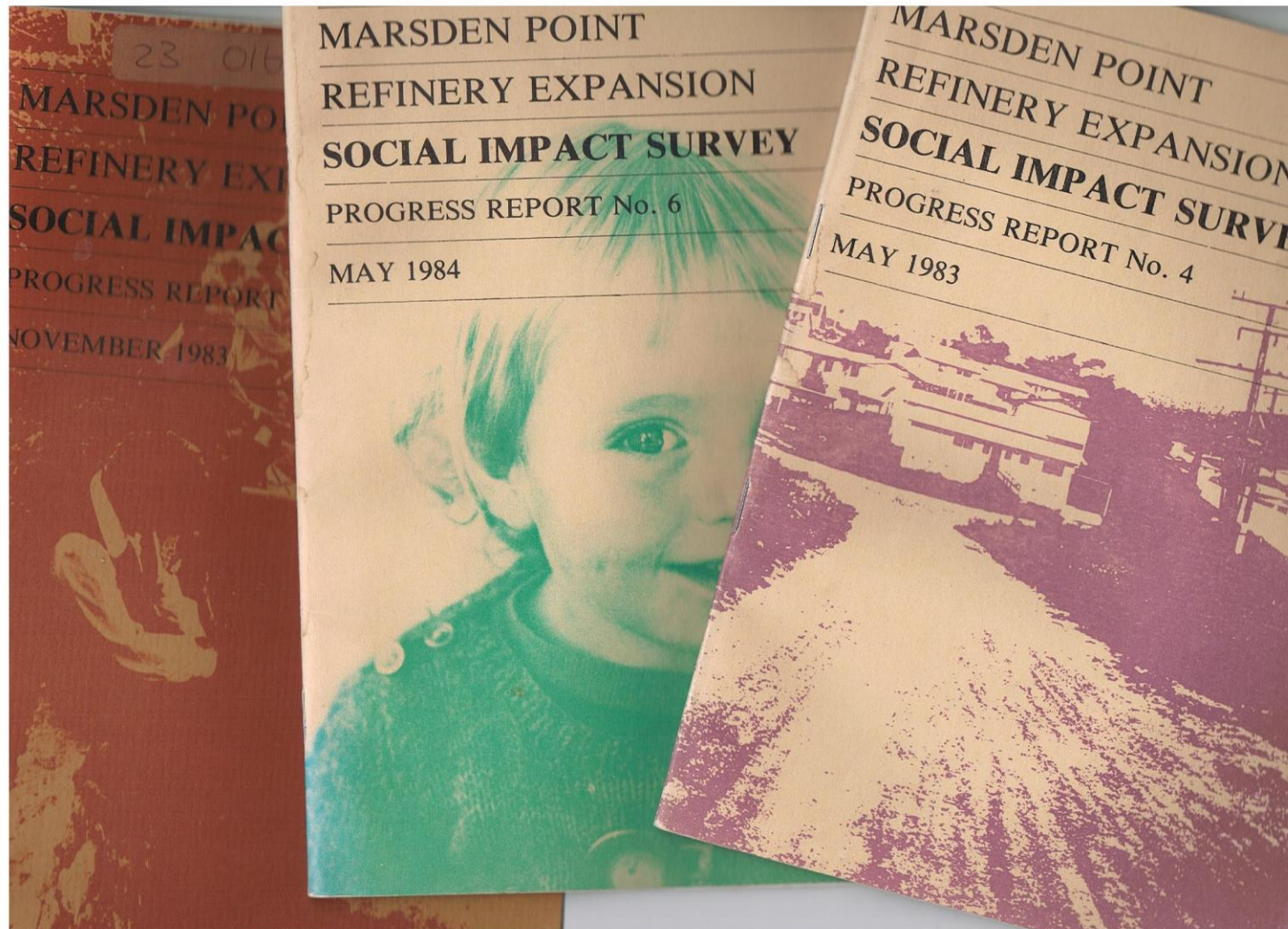
HANMER SOCIAL ASSESSMENT WORKSHOP

Follow chains of effects to their social consequences (Hobson Bryan)

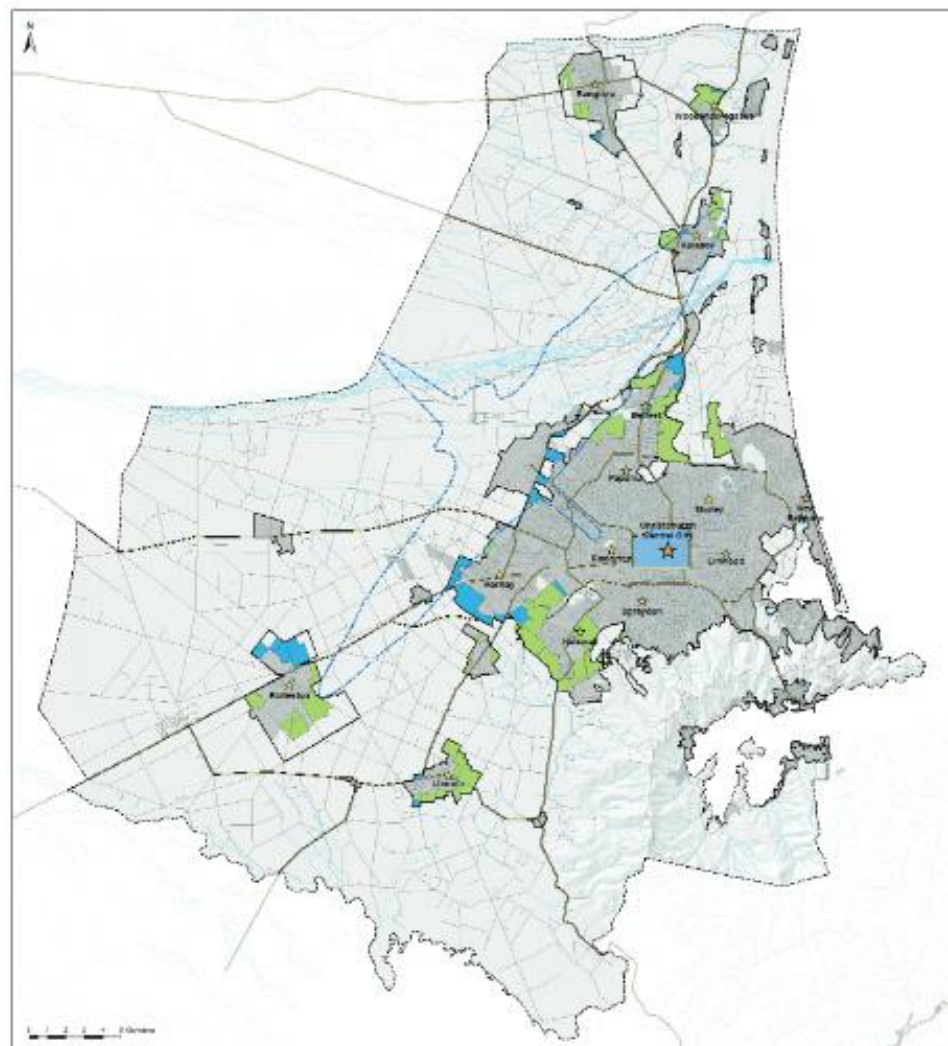
Eg noise, Christchurch's new motorway - great for commuters, but not for residents who cannot sleep from the noise
